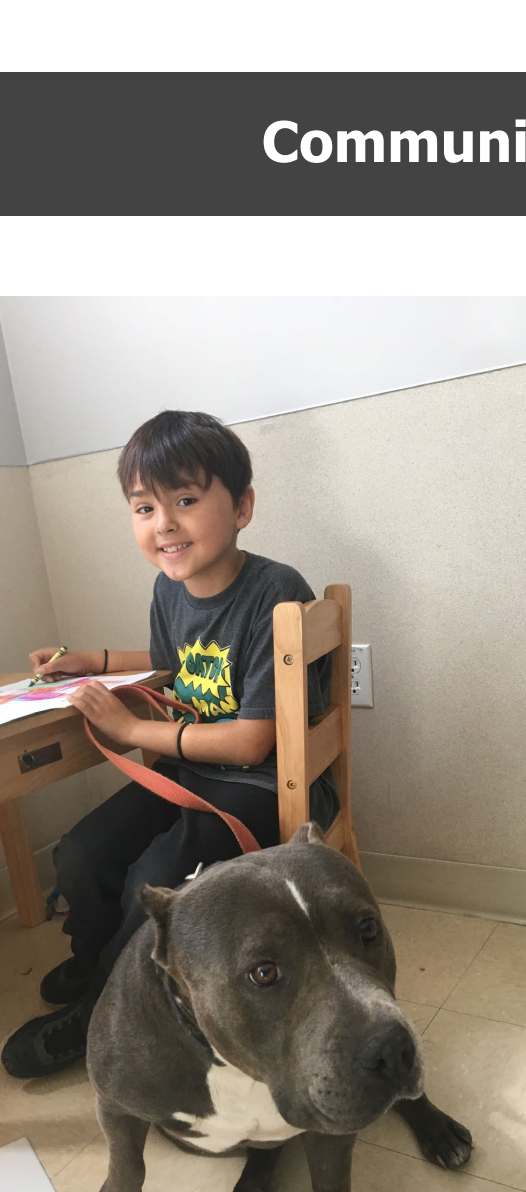

CVC: Hope and Healing For Our Community's Pets

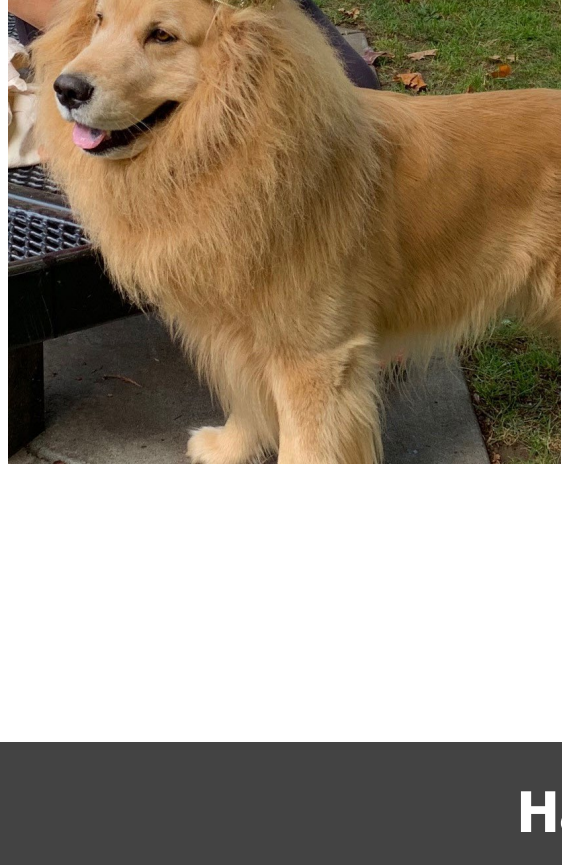

Save the Date For the Howl-O-Ween Pet Parade!

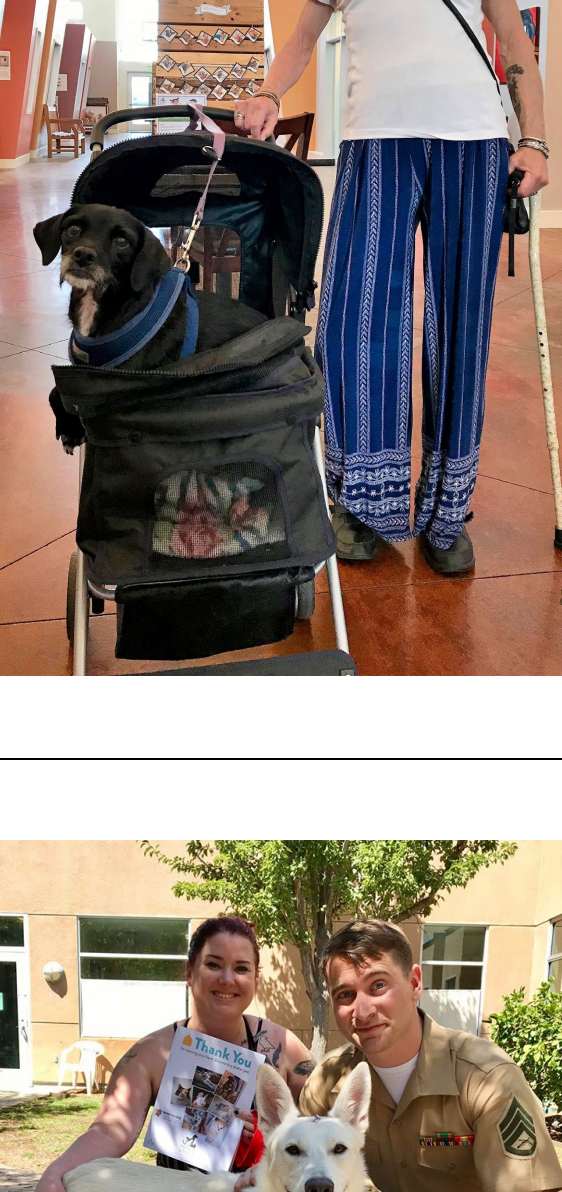
Saturday, October 26, 12-2pm

Healdsburg Plaza - Healdsburg Ave & Matheson St

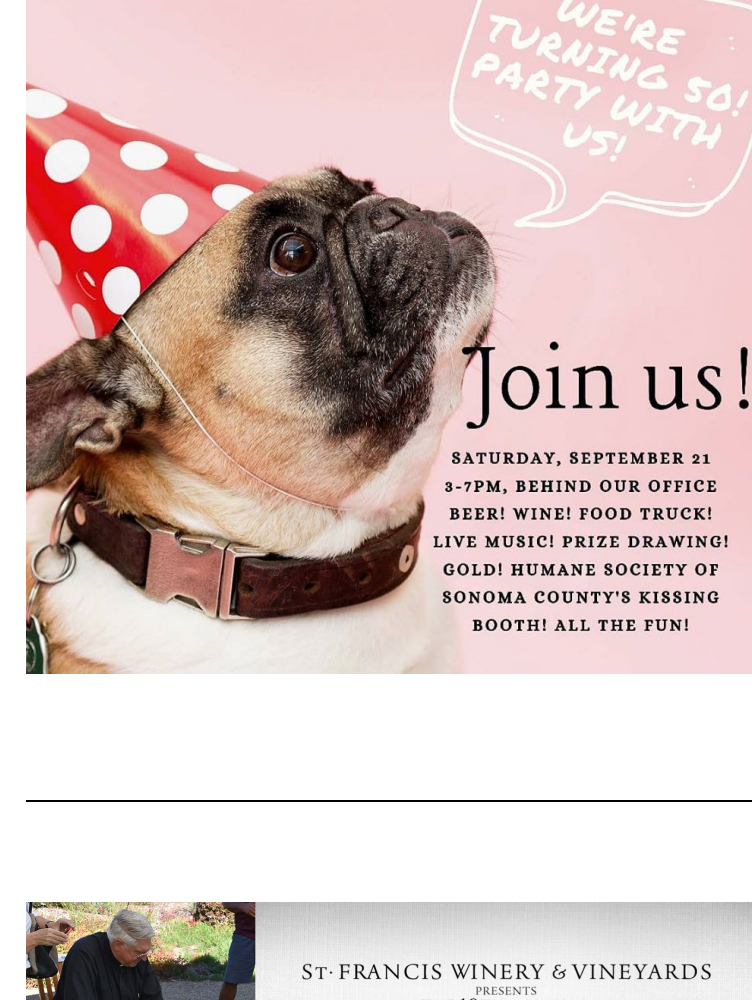

Happy tails, Bailey!

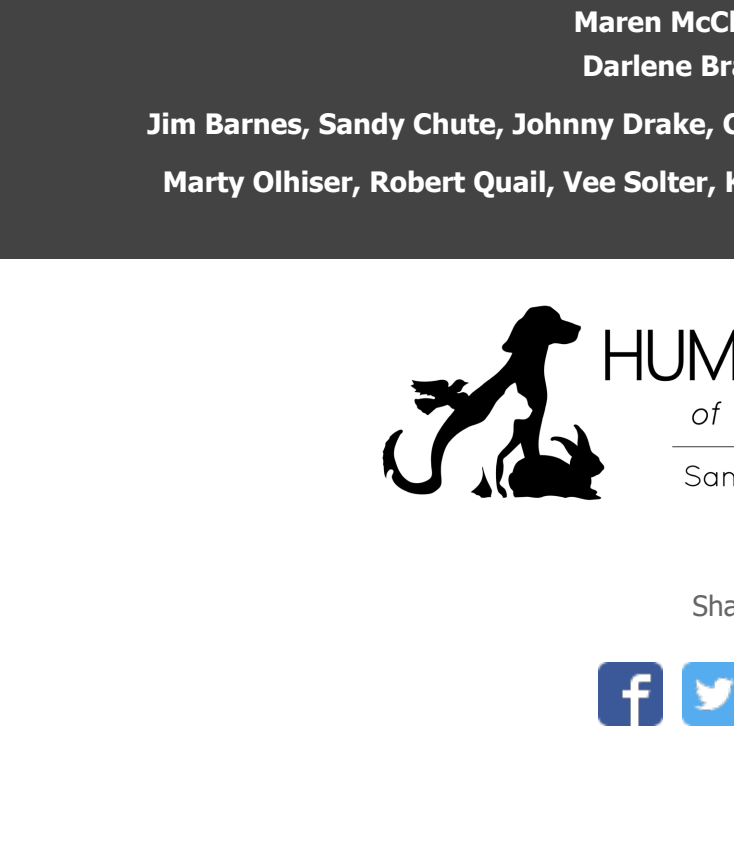

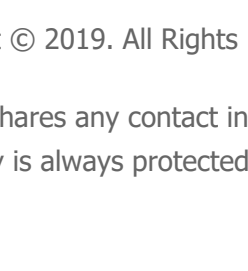

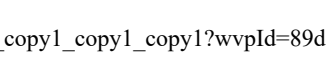
