Zen And The Importance Of Microchipping

Sweet little Zen showed up at our Healdsburg Shelter as a stray last month. He probably knew he didn't belong there, he just didn't have a way to tell us. Luckily, his microchip could do the talking for him! Our team was able to scan his chip and contact his owner to let her know that he was safe with us. As you can imagine, both pup and person were incredibly happy and relieved to be reunited!

Zen represents a minority. As Karrie Stewart, HSSC's Senior Manager of Santa Rosa Adoptions and our Healdsburg Campus says, "28% of the animals who've arrived at our shelter in 2023 have had microchips. The remaining 70%+ were not microchipped when they arrived. Unless owners are actively calling and searching for their pet, we have no way to reach them."

According to Cornell University Shelter Medicine, only 2% of cats and 30% of dogs are returned to their owners when they are lost. With a microchip, that number can increase to 40% for cats and 60% for dogs. About the size of a grain of rice, a microchip is a device that is typically implanted between the animal's shoulder blades. The chip is not a GPS tracker but contains a registration number and the phone number of the registry for the particular brand of chip, which is scanned by

the shelter when an animal is found.

But microchipping is just the first step. Keeping your pet's microchip registry updated with your contact information is the most reliable way to make sure your pet can find their way home. As Karrie Stewart shares, "it can be really hard to re-unite them with their owner if the information is not up to date. If you move or re-home your pet with a friend or family member and the pet gets lost."

May is National Chip Your Pet Month!

It only takes a minute for your pet to slip out of an open door or gate and into a dangerous and potentially heartbreaking situation. Thankfully, it only takes a minute to make sure your pet is chipped and that your contact info is current!

Unsure of your pet's microchip number? Call your vet's office as they may have it in their records OR bring your pet into the vet's office, animal control, or an animal shelter to be scanned. (Pro Tip: make a note of the microchip number on your phone for easy retrieval should your pet ever become lost.)

Does your pet need a microchip? We offer them at no charge at our **free vaccine clinics**! Please call for more info – Santa Rosa (707) 542-0882 or Healdsburg (707) 431-3386.

Update your contact info! Look up your pet's microchip number on the **AAHA Universal Pet Microchip Lookup site**, or check with **my24pet.com**. If your pet is registered, it will tell you where the chip is registered and how to update your contact information if necessary.

Last month, 19 cats were found in crates outside Solano County Animal Care and Control. Once these cats completed their stray holds, the Solano shelter reached out to our Healdsburg shelter to see if we could assist. Luckily, the timing was perfect. The previous group of cats who were living in our large communal cat room, Kitty City, had all recently been adopted! We had plenty of space to take 14 spayed and neutered cats who were ready for transfer.

After the cats arrived, our team went straight to work with intake exams, and one by one got them settled into their new space. tumor removal, a dental cleaning and a few tooth extractions. Her family recently called the CVC and described some medical issues Megan was having and our team knew these were signs of heart failure. We scheduled her for an appointment right away. Our team performed an exam and prescribed her heart medication. After starting her meds, we asked for Megan to come back in for a recheck, and we're happy to say that she's doing well!





Lots of Love for Ludo!!!

An urgent plea came down the pipeline from our partner shelter in Stanislaus, they were frantically searching for another shelter to rescue Ludo. He was scheduled for a 4:30pm euthanasia that very day, and HSSC was his last resort. The subject line in their email wrote "Last Call & LUDO perfect boy! ", when our Admissions team responded with an enthusiastic "Yes we will take him!", the email thread filled with tears and gratitude.

Ludo is a special dog with a deformed right hind leg. When he arrived at HSSC, our shelter medicine team worked to determine exactly what was going on with it. They noted that his tibia and fibula were abnormally short and that he either had a very well developed double dew claw or perhaps an additional toe! They also found that he had a fractured tooth, so when Ludo was getting his neuter surgery, they extracted his broken tooth *and* took radiographs of his leg.

Our team spent some time assessing his mobility and decided that he should keep his limb since he does occasionally use it to help with balance, and it isn't getting in his way. We're very happy this sweet dog could avoid such a daunting surgery. Ludo's leg doesn't slow him down one bit, he's always very happy and active. He zooms around our play yards and has made a ton of friends with staff and volunteers! We're so excited to help this happy dude find the loving home he so deserves. 
