When and Where is the Doggy Dash?

The Doggy Dash is Saturday, May 3rd at Spring Lake Park. The race will kick off at the Boat Launch.

Can I register the day of the event?

Yes! Just note that day of registration is \$40 compared to the regular registration price of \$30.

How do I know if I should bring my dog to Doggy Dash?

If your dog doesn't do well in big crowds or around other dogs, we would suggest leaving them at home. We want everyone to have fun and do not want you or your furry friend to feel stressed in the busy event environment. All dogs must remain on leash at all times.

Do I need to have a dog with me to participate?

No! Come walk and support the Humane Society of Sonoma County with or without your dog. We help more than just dogs including bunnies, cats, guinea pigs, and other small animals. Come show your support for all the animals we help!

Where do I park?

Parking at Spring Lake is \$7 or free with a Sonoma County Regional Parks Pass. There is plenty of parking at the boat ramp; use the south entrance at Newanga Ave. [Here is a copy of the map and directions to get there.](#)

Is the trail accessible?

Spring Lake features wheelchair-accessible trails, picnic areas, campsites and access to the Environmental Discovery Center. Approximately 1.2 miles of the paved Spring Lake Loop trail between the swimming lagoon parking area to the boat launch ramp area has moderate slopes and provides good accessibility.
